As a follow-up to yesterday's legislation referenced below, the *Bill 189, Coronavirus Support and Protection Act, 2020* impacting the *Development Charges, Education* and *Planning Acts,* the province has just released the related **Regulation 149/20: Special Rules Relating to Declared Emergency,** which can be found here: <a href="https://www.ontario.ca/laws/regulation/r20149">https://www.ontario.ca/laws/regulation/r20149</a>.

The provisions in the Regulation take effect immediately.

The Regulation clarifies that despite the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act, **Ontario Regulation 73/20** found here: <a href="https://www.ontario.ca/laws/regulation/200073">https://www.ontario.ca/laws/regulation/200073</a> related to Limitation Periods, **does not apply**.

It outlines very specific provisions around interim-control by-laws; notice of decisions, where they are deemed to be complete; and relates to many *Planning Act* related items/applications – essentially stipulating that all time periods are suspended. The Regulation also affects existing appeals that have been filed.
