On Monday, May 11th the City of Markham's Development Services Committee will be considering items regarding an Update to Development Services, and a Fee Deferral for the processing of Planning Applications and fees or charges for services provided or done by the City. Both items being considered relate to the City's efforts for business continuity for the industry, due to the continued disruptions of COVID-19.

    - o Maintaining Committee of Adjustment Process
    - Policy and Projects Ongoing
    - o Application Decisions During Provincial Emergency
    - o Local Planning Appeal Tribunal Appeals During Provincial Emergency
    - o Public Participation in the Planning Process
  - Regarding Statutory Public Meetings, staff are bringing recommendations forward for Committees endorsement to allow the City to move forward with Electronic Public Meetings;
- 2. Fee deferral: tariff of fees for the processing of planning applications & fees or charges for services or activities provided or done by the city (city-wide);
  - Staff are recommending amendments to <u>By-law 2002-276</u>, and <u>By-law 211-83</u> as amended by 2019-137, in order to prescribe a Tariff of Fees for the processing of Planning Applications;
  - This amendment intends to provide financial relief to the development industry for the
    deferral of fees for services or activities related to the processing of development
    applications for the 2020 calendar year, as it relates to COVID-19 relief efforts;
  - Please note, Staff will also be bringing forward an additional amendment to By-law 2002-276, in order to reflect the 2020 annual adjustment for the Residential Infill Grading and Servicing Fee from 26% to 28.6%.
