


The Industry's Economic Impact (GTA, 2011)...




- 41, 292 new housing starts key to economic growth (2011)






For the WHAT...

Metrolinx – The Big Move:



- Aggressive \$50 billion Regional Transportation Plan in 25 years
- Initial "5 in 10" plan identified five priority projects in 10 years with \$9.5 billion budget
- Original political Board of Directors replaced with non-political appointees
- Metrolinx plans to roll out investment strategy consultations in 2013 to fund transit expansion beyond the initial \$9.5 billion commitment to Toronto & York Region

In Toronto ...



- Earlier this year politics around plans Mayor and City Council
- Province (Metrolinx) supported council approved plan
- Region faces massive infrastructure back log
- Growing political opposition to intensification outside downtown core
- Toronto-York-Spadina-Subway is funded & under construction (\$2.6 billion)
- Cost for next phase of transit expansion:
 - Provincial Gov't has allocated \$8.4 billion
 - Federal Gov't has allocated \$333 million for Sheppard
 - Mayor Rob Ford's plan required additional \$3 \$4 billion in funding
 - Requested private sector assistance

Our *Investment* Challenges & Opportunities

- BILD supports the Big Move Regional Transportation Plan
- Recognizing that BILD and its members are your PARTNER in building complete communities, our contribution to the funding of the Plan must be part of a fair and equitable strategy
- Any investment strategy must be broad based and include an array of funding tools
- Elevate and widen the debate it cannot be all about DCs
- The investment strategy should not target a specific group both existing and new residents will benefit from faster and more reliable service
- Long-term commitment and participation from all levels of government is essential - with secure and dedicated funding

Our *City Building* Challenges & Opportunities

Do we all understand the vision?

- The GTA is undergoing a fundamental paradigm shift in terms of development patterns and commuter modes of travel
- More compact, mixed use communities are required & better live-work proximity is essential
- Intensification should focus on regional centres, regional corridors, and transit stations
- Each municipality will play a role in intensification and transit-oriented development, and should align their various planning policies to make it happen – official plans, zoning by-laws and guidelines

Our <u>Growth Plan</u> related Challenges & Opportunities We WILL grow!

- The people ARE coming and we have to plan for them NOW!
- The Greater Golden Horseshoe is the 3rd fastest growing urban region in North America
- 3.7million more people and 1.8million more jobs are expected by 2031
- Municipalities are required to meet provincial target of 40% intensification

We need to hear the Provincial voice of support...

Key Messages- Moving Forward

- Investment must be targeted to support jobs and economic development
- Public infrastructure investment supports private sector investment
- Any transit and transportation investment strategy must be aligned to Growth Plan principles
- Objectives and implementation of the Regional Transportation Plan and the Growth Plan must be aligned
- We need greater planning certainty and transit investment certainty through longterm planning
- The Province has an opportunity to show leadership in centers and corridors
- Through its consultation on the Big Move, Metrolinx has the opportunity to show support for good planning principles of intensification and building complete communities that support Growth Plan objectives
- We must all work together to make sure that the appropriate regulatory framework to support intensification is in place - streamlined approvals, incentives and as-of-right zoning are key
- BILD supports a National Transit Strategy and closer cooperation between provincial and federal government

The time for implementation is NOW...

Looking Forward - Moving Forward

- BILD is *supportive* of the Regional Transportation Plan and we will be partners in making it happen
- The residential and non-residential building and development industry are *your partners* in *community building*
- Local government must plan for a full range of housing and employment options and choice in developing complete communities
