

TORONTO: BILD Advocacy to Restore Service & Notice of May Meeting Cancellations

As a reminder to the below, on April 30th Mayor Tory has called a special meeting of City Council to consider, among other many other matters, a presentation and reports on the management of the current emergency, including any actions requiring Council decision to aid in the ongoing management of the emergency. In advance of this meeting, BILD submitted [a letter](#) in response to agenda item [CC20.2 City of Toronto Response and the Ongoing Management of Emergency City Business during the COVID-19 Pandemic](#) (Ward All). This letter recommends that the City safely restore all services related to development applications, which would include accepting new planning and building permit applications. Further, in acknowledgement of the City Council and Committee meetings that have been cancelled for the month of May (outlined below), BILD has also recommended that staff be granted the necessary delegated authority to process development applications where a Council decision would otherwise be required.
