## **Township of King - Building Services Update - COVID-19**

Please be advised that the Township of King has amended their service levels as it relates to Building Inspections and Building Permits in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Regarding building inspections, the Township will continue to schedule and conduct a modified inspection structure that currently does not include the inspection of occupied dwellings (subject to adjustment.) Staff request that members book inspections by email only at <a href="mailto:inspections@king.ca">inspections@king.ca</a>. Building Permit Applications are still being accepted and processed. The Township is only accepting applications by hard copy via the drop-box at the Municipal Centre between 8:30am to 3:00pm, however staff are establishing an online submission procedure. As well, all meetings with external clients will be completed by telephone only at this time.

Although the processing and review of building permit applications will continue, the Building Division will now be holding building permit issuance in abeyance until the Provincial Order respecting construction has been lifted. BILD Staff hope to have further discussion on this shifting service decision at tomorrow's York Chapter Meeting.
