Through BILD's continued efforts for additional service, the Town of Aurora has provided further updates to their planning and building services amid the ever-changing developments around COVID-19.

Regarding Planning Services, Town staff will continue to process active applications and undertake pre-consultation meetings. All staff continue to be accessible by email and phone, and are equipped to undertake virtual meetings with applicants as necessary. For the month of April staff will not be accepting major planning applications, at the time in which this changes, BILD will let members know. Additionally, [Council and General Committee meetings](#) will commence by video conferencing on April 14th.

As for Building Services, staff are still scheduling inspections and will still receive inspection requests but not for interior renovations. The Town will be accepting smaller building permits digitally and will continue to process zoning and plan reviews.
